

# Same-Day Discharge Protocol for PCI

<b>1. Patient Selection</b>			
▪ Less than 75 years of age			
▪ LVEF greater than or equal to 30%			
▪ Creatinine Clearance greater than or equal to 30 or Creatinine level less than 2.5			
▪ INR less than or equal to 2.0 unless radial access used			
▪ No ACS			
▪ No uncontrolled DM or HTN			
▪ No severe valvular heart disease			
▪ Able to ambulate without difficulty			
▪ HGB level greater than 10 and platelet count more than 100K, unless radial access used			
<b>2. Angiographic and Procedural</b>			
▪ Absence of major complications, persistent minor procedural events, or hemodynamic shifts			
▪ LVEF greater than or equal to 30%			
▪ No proximal bifurcation requiring dual stents			
▪ No significant dissection or access site complication			
▪ No implantation of more than 3 stents or >28mm stent in single vessel PCI			
▪ No left main stem disease			
▪ PCI not done on the ONLY single vessel supplying the heart			
▪ No need for GP IIB/IIIa infusion following procedure			
▪ No CTO			
▪ No PTCA except for treatment of in-stent restenosis

# Same-Day Discharge Protocol for PCI (Cont.)

<b>3. Post-Procedural</b>			
▪ No chest pain post-PCI			
▪ Adequate supervision or home support			
▪ Lives within 30 miles of a hospital with ER facility			
▪ Able to fill meds same day or next day			
▪ Working home or cell phone for emergency contact and post-procedural call			
▪ Evaluation by cardiologist or advance practice clinician			
▪ Post-procedure EKG without major changes			
▪ Adequate hydration of at least 1 liter prior to discharge			
▪ Ambulate at least 30-60 minutes prior to discharge			
▪ Loading dose of antiplatelet if not already taking			
<b>4. Discharge</b>			
▪ Written discharge instructions			
▪ Discharge by 8 PM			
▪ Heart and Vascular Center RN must conduct phone call within 24-48 hours			
▪ Follow-up visit scheduled within 7 days post-discharge			
▪ Cardiac rehab referral must be completed
